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OUR COMMITMENT TO YOUR HEALTH & SAFETY BURNHAM-ON-SEA SWIM & SPORTS ACADEMY

To our valued customers & employees, we want to make sure you always feel safe when you visit the Academy. We are monitoring the Covid-19 issue closely.

We want to let you know what we are doing to keep the Academy clean & safe for your use. Firstly we have asked the question

Is it safe to go swimming at this time?

Our water quality management & treatment services (Broadwater Technologies) has consulted with PWTAG (Pool Water Treatment Advisory Group), who in turn have consulted with Public Health England to determine the answer to this question. They QUOTED "We have checked with our national leads who confirm that coronavirus would be inactivated at the levels of chlorine used in swimming pools". Public Health's opinion is that water and the chlorine within swimming pools will help to kill the virus.

This is obviously great news for our swimmers!

The Academy carries out frequent, regular testing of the pool water for PH and disinfectant/chlorine levels 4 times a day. The PH and disinfectant levels comply with PWTAG advice & bacteriological tests of pool water are carried out by Broadwater technology specialists.

The Academy environment (both wet & dry sides) are cleaned multiple times throughout the day following a vigorous checklist. We used high grade disinfectant products & are committed to increasing the frequency of our deep cleans at this time.

Interaction of pool users beyond the swimming activity, is where we need your help in observing & practicing good public hygiene:

DO

- ✓ Shower before & after entering the pool
- ✓ Wash your hands with soap and water often – do this for at least 20 seconds
- ✓ Always wash your hands when you get home or into work
- ✓ Use hand sanitiser gel if soap and water are not available
- ✓ Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue or your sleeve (not your hands) when you cough or sneeze
- ✓ Put used tissues in the bin straight away and wash your hands afterwards
- ✓ Try to avoid close contact with people who are unwell

Don't

- X Do not touch your eyes, nose or mouth if your hands are not clean
